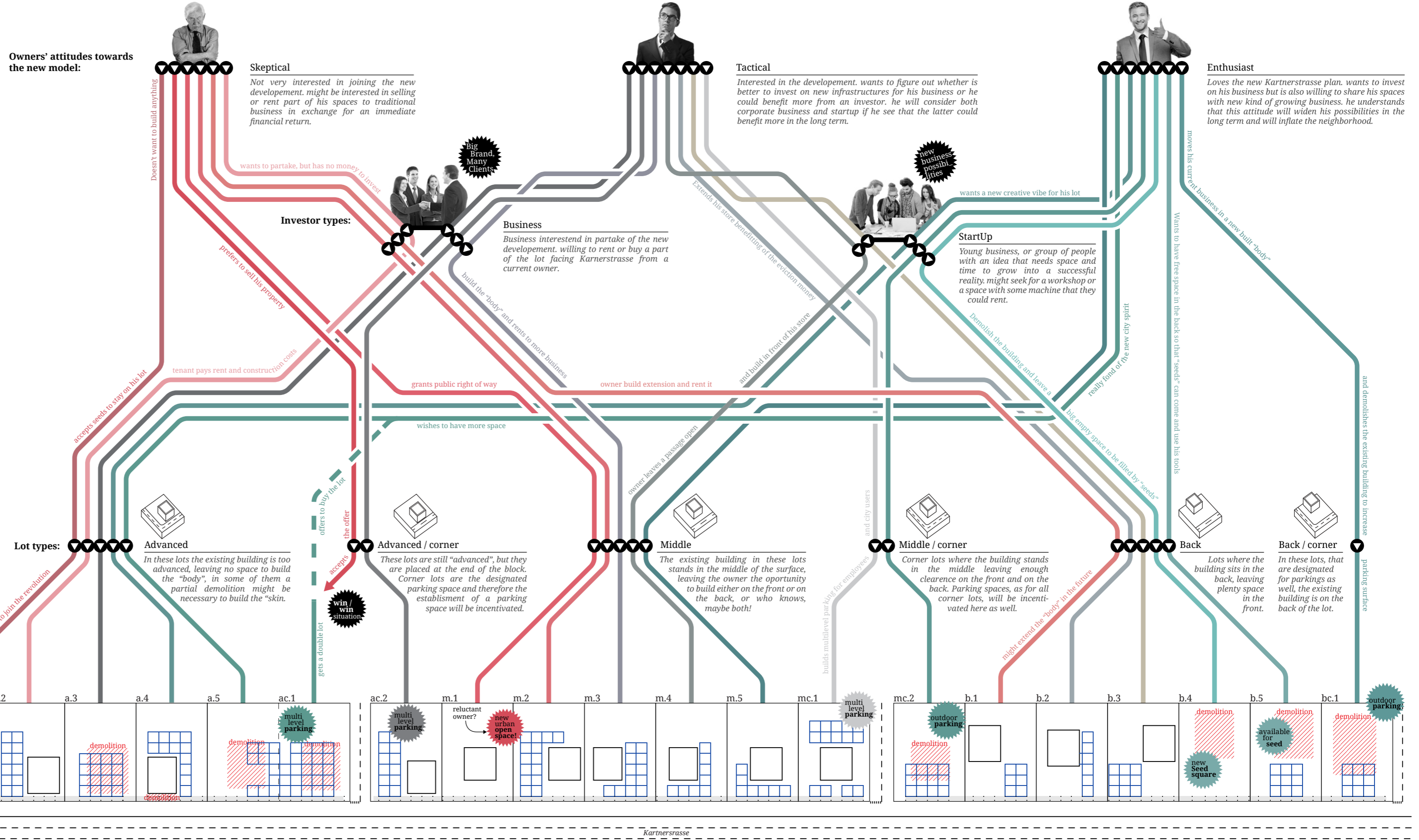
What's the best way to change Kärntner Strasse with an economically sustainable project (for the city)?

A flexible project, capable to adapt itself to the different scenarios of an unpredictable future and to the various wills and the changing needs of its inhabitants.

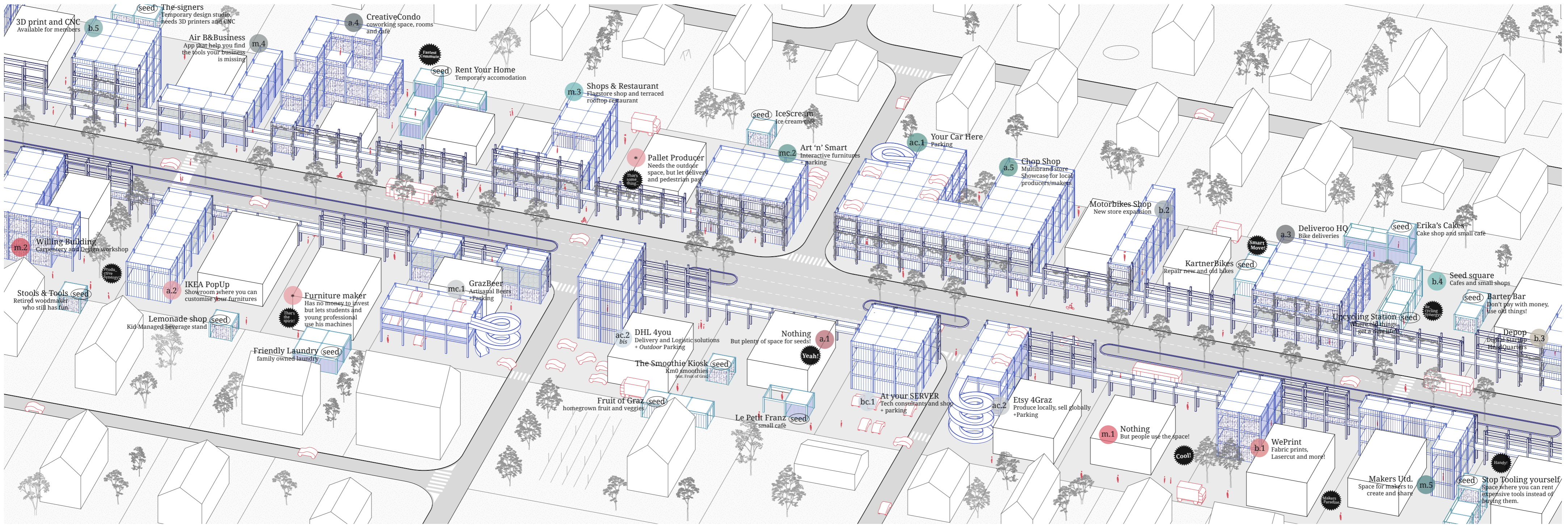
A project that will grow with the contribution of the whole community, enlivened by the ideas of the citizens, supported by public and private investments.

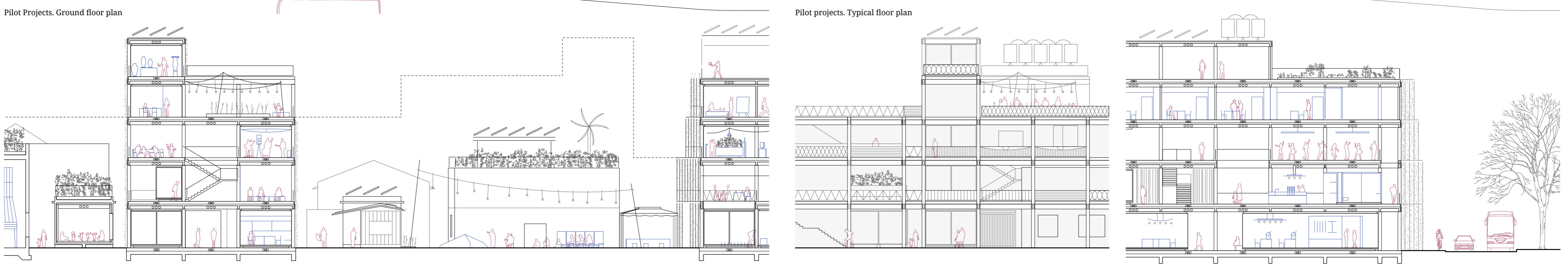
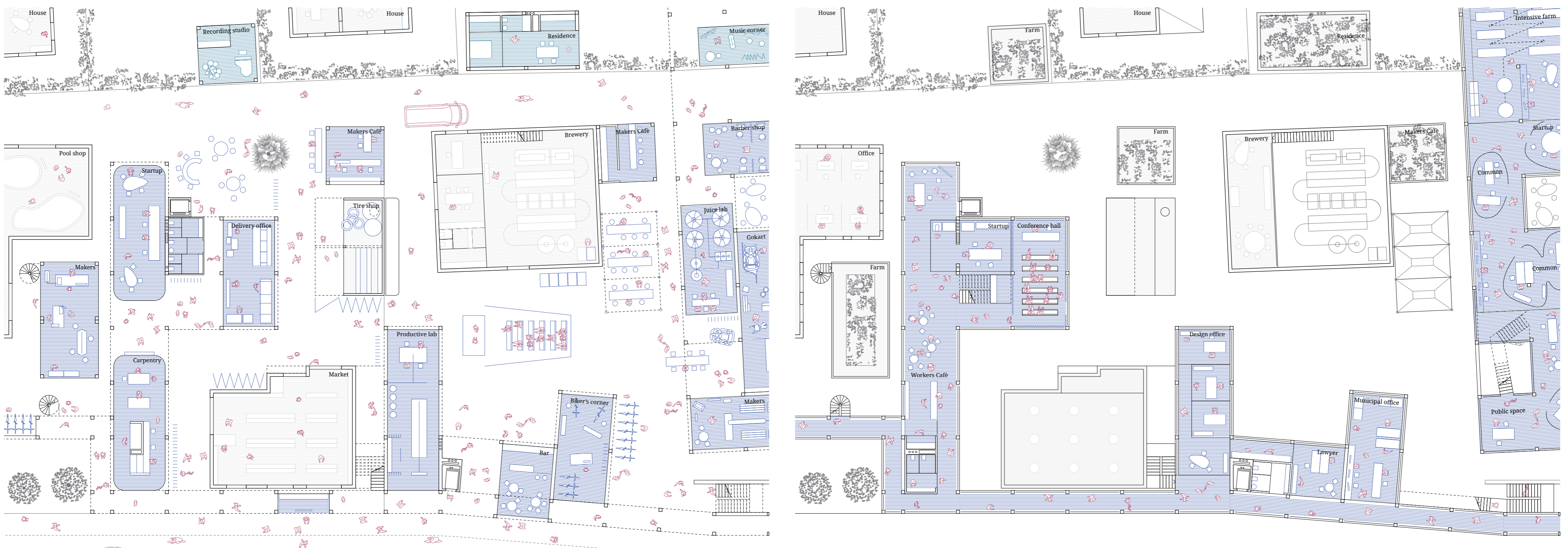
